Location of Action: Midway State Park is located in the Hamlet of Maple Springs in the Town of Ellery, Chautauqua County

Description of Action: The Master Plan for Midway State Park provides long term guidance for the development and management of the park and protection of its resources. The Executive Summary of the Master Plan and FEIS is attached. It contains a brief summary which describes the proposed action, the environmental setting, alternatives and potential environmental impacts and mitigation.
