

Application for Marine Regatta Permit Instructions

- 1. <u>The completed application MUST be received in its entirety or it will not be processed.</u>
 Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
- **2.** Attach accurate section of chart, or **scale drawing** of the waterway upon which the regatta is to be held, indicating the boundaries of the Regatta area, the various courses, areas to be used for official boats, starting and finishing lines, launching pits, area to be used for spectator craft, how various areas are marked, location of officials' stand, distances from shore, etc. The drawing must show that other recreational and commercial boating traffic has sufficient room to maneuver around the event. If not, details about how said traffic will be guided through the course during the event must be included in the application.
- **3.** Submit the application and drawing to the local county sheriff's office if they operate a marine patrol. If not, applications should be submitted to NYS Park Police. On Lake George, applications must be submitted to both the local county sheriff's office and the Lake George Park Commission. The reviewing officer must sign the drawing and complete the attached **Marine Law Enforcement Regatta Review** indicating that they have been notified and indicate any objections to the event. This should be done prior to submitting the application to the state office in Albany.
- **4.** Applications MUST be submitted **at least 30 days prior to the date of the event.** Enclose a check or money order in the proper amount. **Do not send cash.**

- **5. Special Navigation Inspectors.** A minimum of three persons must be listed as Special Navigation Inspectors. The inspectors ARE REQUIRED to be familiar with all provisions of the New York State Navigation Law and are expected to take necessary measures to ensure the safety of participants, spectators or any other persons during the authorized regatta. They shall also assist in helping boat traffic through the regatta area as needed. The "Person-in-Charge", law enforcement and on-call emergency personal can not be listed as a Special Navigation Inspector.
- **6.** The Person-in-Charge of the Regatta shall be responsible for properly completing the "Special Navigation Inspectors Joint Report" and returning WITHIN 48 HOURS after completion of each event. Accidents during an event should be detailed in this report. **Failure to submit this report may result in a denial of future permits.**
