1			<p>What is the quantity typically ordered for scheduled delivery versus not scheduled? The contract states approximate annual amount for each category but trying to gauge the expected quantity range per each work order issued for a delivery.</p>	<p>Please refer to IFB Section 2.3 Delivery Requirements and Timeframes for estimated amounts of sand needed. All deliveries will be scheduled. Some may be on an emergency basis and some will be non-emergency basis.</p> <p>The information you are requesting is not available; however, OPRHP has provided Exhibit C - Summary of Past Clean Beach Sand Deliveries to Long Island Region.</p> <p>Bidders are reminded that quantities are estimated and OPRHP will only pay for clean beach sand ordered and delivered to OPRHP locations. There is no guarantee that OPRHP will use any or all the estimated cubic yards of sand.</p>
2			<p>Bridge and Weight restrictions associated with each delivery location. Being that there are 7 delivery locations in total. In anticipation that the route to each location will contain specific roadway/bridge/weight restrictions, I am wondering if the State Park Department has a current list of bridge crossing and restrictions, etc that are associated with each location?</p>	<p>The bridge to Robert Moses State Park <del>is subject to a 7-ton weight limit</del> (Fire Island Inlet Bridge) is an R-posted bridge requiring a <u>permit with NYSDOT. Please refer to <a href="https://www.dot.ny.gov/gisapps/posted-bridges/r-posted-bridge-limitation">https://www.dot.ny.gov/gisapps/posted-bridges/r-posted-bridge-limitation</a> for more information. Awardee will be responsible to apply and secure a permit with NYSDOT prior to the use of the bridge.</u></p> <p>There are Parkway restrictions (no commercial vehicles allowed) for Jones Beach, Heckscher, Sunken Meadow, Robert Moses and Captree State Park. However, all of these Parks have special commercial vehicle driving directions which will allow commercial vehicles to safely and lawfully access the Park. The awarded contractor will be provided these directions.</p> <p><u>Restrictions are beyond OPRHP's control and are subject to change.</u></p>
