MUNICIPAL ENDORSEMENT

Required only for Park projects (not Historic Preservation or Heritage Area Projects)

Not-for-profit organizations must attach the endorsement of the municipality in which the project is located. For projects involving **multiple** municipalities, endorsement is required from the municipality with planning jurisdiction (e.g., the county) **and all** municipalities owning affected property.
