

# West River Shoreline Enhancement

This project will enhance habitat and views along 6.5 miles of the West River Shoreline Trail, located between Buckhorn Island State Park and Beaver Island State Park.

Multiple woodland invasive species, such as honeysuckle and buckthorn, have reduced the quality of habitat for native plants and animals, and block views of the river from the trail. The project aims to remove these species through mechanical methods and replace them with low growing native plants to enhance the local area and restore views.

Removal and restoration activities will occur over a three year time span.
