Park Etiquette

Be respectful of others by keeping noise to a minimum level and keeping your campsite clean and litter free.

- Quiet Hours: 10 PM - 7 AM
- Generator Hours: 9 AM - 11 AM and 5 PM - 9 PM

It is **illegal to collect** anything on state lands. Plants, fossils, rocks and animals are important parts of the park experience. Wellesley Island State Park is home to many wild creatures.

Respect wildlife by not feeding or harassing any wildlife while visiting the park.

- If you see any wildlife that appears ill, leave it alone and contact park personnel.
- Secure all food in your vehicle before leaving your campsite or retiring for the evening.

Respect the trees, they are protected by law.

- Do not put nails or screws into trees.
- Do not cut down trees or cut limbs off trees.

Smoking is prohibited in all park buildings and structures.

Minna Anthony Common Nature Center

The Nature Center, located beyond the Heron camping area, is dedicated to environmental education and preservation. At the Nature Center visitors can hike the approximately 10 miles of trails through a variety of terrains, visit the butterfly house, explore the educational displays, and peruse the museum gift shop. During the summer a variety of programming is available, including guided hikes, arts and crafts, birds of prey demonstrations, and the popular Voyageur Canoe trips. The Nature Center is open all year with skiing and snowshoeing in the winter. The trails are open dawn to dusk. The museum building is open 8am-4pm daily.

- Park Rules**
1. Quiet hours between 10 pm and 7 am are strictly enforced. Also, any use of generators is limited to 9-11 AM and 5-9 PM.
 2. All pets must be secured by a 6 foot or shorter leash and under complete control at all times.
 3. Pets are prohibited on the beach, picnic areas and cottages.
 4. Swimming at guarded bathing areas only and only when lifeguards are on duty.
 5. All plants, trees and animals are protected by law.
