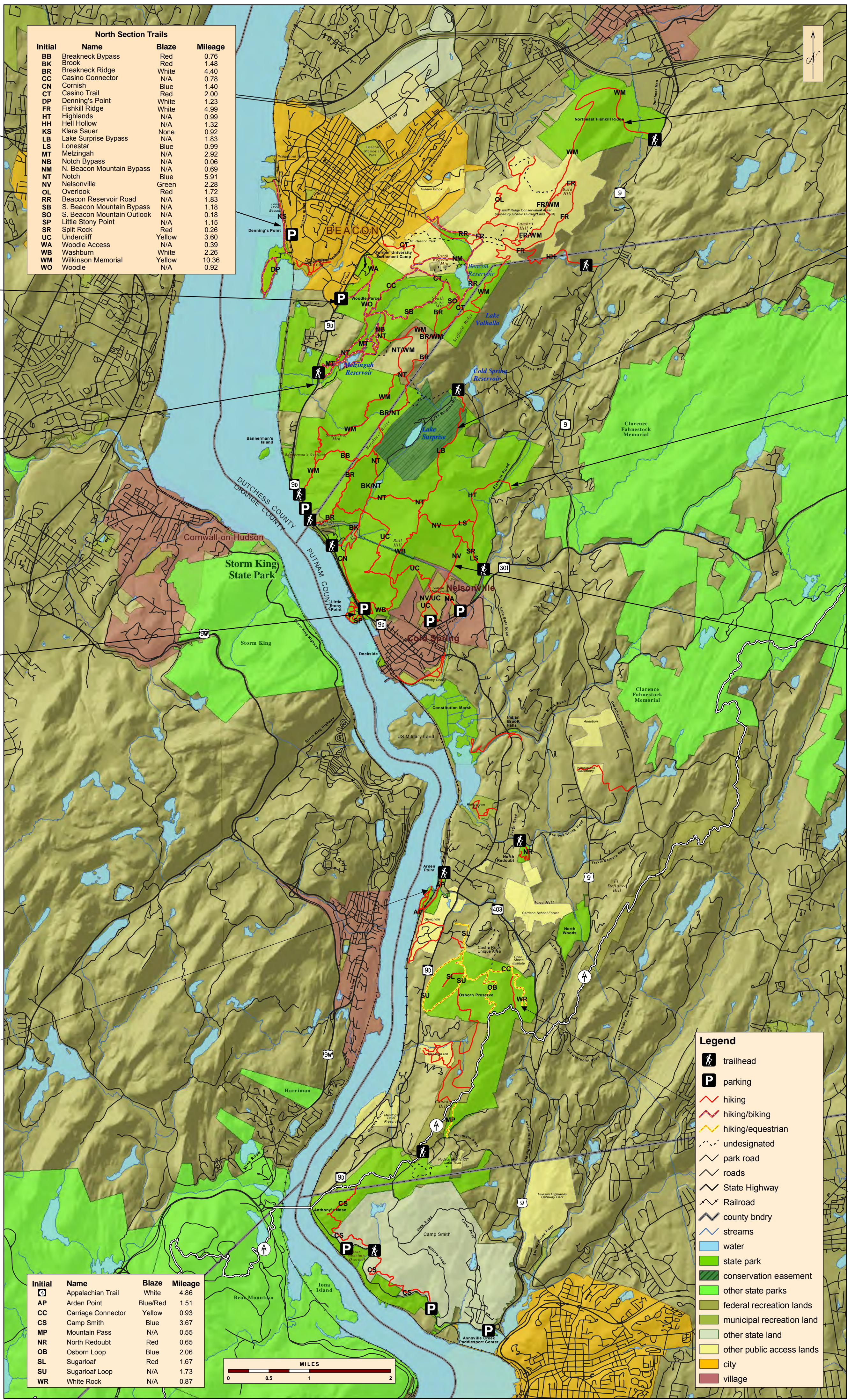


- General (North)**
- Maintain the trail system for designated uses including hiking, biking, cross country skiing and snowshoeing.
 - Improve the trail system through upgrades to unsustainable sections of trail and closure of some undesignated trails.
 - Improve trail signage including trailhead and trail intersection signage.
 - Allow hiking and snowshoeing on all existing, newly developed and newly designated trails.
 - Enhance mountain biking opportunities.
 - Enhance trailhead parking facilities in a number of locations.

- General (North) Continued**
- Increase interpretation of natural, cultural and historical resources along trails and through other media.
 - Continue and expand coordination with volunteer groups for the development and maintenance of the trail system.
 - Develop a long-term maintenance and monitoring plan, including a Summit Stewardship Program/Volunteer Ambassador Program, to ensure continued sustainability of the trail system.
 - Maintain and enhance connections to external trail systems, communities and mass transportation.



- Klara Sauer Trail**
- Designate the trail for ungroomed cross country skiing.

- Visitor Center**
- Develop a parking lot/ trailhead at the new Visitor Center.

- Multi-use Trails**
- Designate/Develop a network of trails for hiking and mountain biking.
 - Coordinate with Scenic Hudson for access, development and maintenance of trails.

- Little Stony Point**
- Designate Trails for hiking and snowshoeing
 - Install intersection signage and blaze trails (hiking only).
 - Designate Little Stony Point Trail for ungroomed cross country skiing.

- Arden Point**
- Designate Arden Point as a Hudson Valley Greenway Water Trail Site.
 - Designate Arden Point Trail for ungroomed cross country skiing.

- Northeast Fishkill Ridge**
- Designate/Develop a trail to connect the Fishkill Ridge Trail to Route 9 (extension of the Wilkinson Memorial Trail).
 - Develop a small parking area along Clove Road at Route 9.

- Lake Surprise vicinity**
- Designate a trail from Lake Surprise Road to the Notch Trail.

- Highlands Trail**
- Designate/Develop trails as part of the regional Highlands Trail.

- Nelsonville Trail**
- Designate the trail for ungroomed cross country skiing.

- Multi-use Trails**
- Designate a network of trails for hiking and equestrian use.
 - Coordinate with DEC for horse trailer parking improvements at Castle Rock Unique Area for access in to the trail system.

- General (South)**
- Maintain the trail system for designated uses including hiking, horseback riding, cross country skiing and snowshoeing.
 - Improve the trail system through upgrades to unsustainable sections of trail and closure of some undesignated trails.
 - Improve trail signage including trailhead and trail intersection signage.
 - Allow hiking and snowshoeing on all existing, newly developed and newly designated trails.
 - Enhance equestrian opportunities.
 - Enhance trailhead parking facilities in a number of locations.
