4th Street Entrance Improvements

The project work is scheduled to occur until May 15th, 2023 and will resume in the fall of 2023. Artpark's box office and programs will remain open for typical operations.

Improvements at the 4th street entrance will create a more appropriate sense of arrival and assist with site circulation. A new asphalt pathway on the east side of the entrance will enhance public access by creating a safer area for pedestrians into the park separate from vehicle access. The existing toll booth will be removed and new toll structures will be installed at the northwest entrance to the parking lot. The main lot will be transformed into a sustainable parking area including reinforced turf parking and multiuse space. It will be fully accessible for use throughout the 2023 performance season. Overlook and Switchback Improvements

The project offers the opportunity to link the Shoreline Trail to the heart of Artpark State Park through an experiential switchback route and a direct path down the Niagara Escarpment. A scenic overlook will be constructed at the top of the slope, allowing visitors to take in the views of Artpark and the Niagara River Gorge and to provide interpretation about the park and surrounding trails. Throughout the switchback will be a "scramble" staircase section created out of various size and shapes of boulders. The site will receive 165 trees and 5,400 shrubs.
