

MUNICIPAL ENDORSEMENT

Not-for-profits must attach the endorsement of the municipality in which the project is located. For projects involving multiple municipalities, endorsement is required from the municipality with planning jurisdiction (e.g., the county) and all municipalities owning affected property.

ACCEPTABLE SAMPLE MUNICIPAL ENDORSEMENT

WHEREAS, the (not-for-profit organization name) is applying to the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) for a grant under the (Environmental Protection Fund for a park project *or* Recreational Trails Program for a trail project) to be located (location), a site located within the territorial jurisdiction of this (Board, Council or Legislature); and

WHEREAS, as a requirement under the rules of these programs, said not-for-profit corporation must obtain the "approval/endorsement of the governing body of the municipality in which the project will be located";

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by this august body that the (Board, Council or Legislature) of (municipality) hereby does approve and endorse the application of (Not-For-Profit) for a grant under the (Environmental Protection Fund for a park project *or* Recreational Trails Program for a trail project) known as (project title) and located within this community.

If the project is taking place on municipally-owned land, the following must be added:
