1. ALL activities on State Park lands are regulated. Please check with the Park office if you have any questions. **All New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation and Department of Environmental Conservation rules and regulations apply.**
2. Each person must obtain and possess a permit while hunting on State Park Lands.
3. Before hunting in the park, you must register. Permits are available at the self registration box outside the park office. You need to register only once for all hunting seasons and dates. After registering, please keep this copy of the permit with you while you are hunting. This permit is valid from 9/1/14 through 3/31/15.
4. Spring turkey hunting WITH BOW ONLY is allowed with a Special Use Permit in conjunction with this Hunting Permit.
5. NO FIREARM HUNTING DURING SPRING TURKEY HUNTING SEASON ANYWHERE ON DARIEN LAKES STATE PARK LANDS.
6. Hunting with firearms or crossbows is permitted EAST of Eleven Mile Creek only, all DEC rules and regulations apply.
7. Bow hunting is permitted in all areas of the park, except for campground, disc golf, and picnic areas
8. Bow hunters with valid hunting permits will be allowed to register to camp in the camping areas from 9/30/14 through 10/18/14. All bows must remain locked in a case and stored in vehicles while in the camping area and Harlow Lake Day use areas. Access to hunting areas must be from outside the campgrounds and day use areas. Deer that are taken in the park are not allowed to be kept in the campground or day use areas. For more camping information, please call the Park office.
9. All forms of target shooting, including sighting in guns, are prohibited.
10. Permanent tree stands are PROHIBITED. Portable tree stands are allowed but must be removed by dark on DECEMBER 19th.
11. Motorized vehicles are prohibited, except snowmobiles when conditions allow.
12. Park lands are within WMU 8G.
13. Trained dogs or dogs in training are allowed to be off leash EAST of eleven mile creek while in the act of small game hunting or small game training.
