Excerpts from Rules and Regulations

Section 375.1 -- FIREARMS AND WEAPONS. (p) No person, other than a member of a Federal, State or municipal law enforcement agency, shall introduce or possess either upon the person or within a vehicle, or use any firearm or any instrument or weapon the propelling force of which is a spring, rubber or air or any ammunition or propellant therefor, or a bow and arrow, except for hunting where permitted by a rule or regulation of a regional park and recreation commission.

Section 391.2 -- HUNTING AND TRAPPING. (a) No person shall molest, hunt or trap any wild animal or bird or have any such wild animal or bird in his possession within any park unless under permit or as excepted in subdivisions (b) or (c) of this section; (b) Waterfowl hunting, as authorized by the provisions of the Environmental Conservation Law, is permitted in designated areas but shall be absolutely prohibited within 500 feet of a park or parkway boundary, the outer edge of a paved road or any structure. (c) Carp hunting with a longbow, as permitted and regulated by the Environmental Conservation Law, will be allowed within those areas of Lake Ontario State Parkway lands between Route 19 and the westerly Rochester City line, which lie more than 20 feet from: (1) the park or parkway property line or (2) the outer edge of any pavement, or (3) any park building, except that no hunting will be permitted within parkway lands south of the parkway pavement between Lowden Point Road and Long Pond Road.

(d) The erection of permanent hunting blinds is prohibited. The use of natural vegetation for the erection of temporary hunting blinds in areas designated for waterfowl hunting is hereby permitted. Filed Sec. of State 1/22/75.
