




**It is important to write the proper Hunting License ID# on your application and not a Doc# !**

The correct ID number immediately follows the letters "ID#" and is usually but not always the same as the large center number on the back tag. Here is where to find the proper numbers:

The Venison Donation Coalition in New York State is in need of financial donations to keep this program successful. Donations of one dollar or more can make a difference. This money stays in New York State to feed local people who are struggling to feed themselves and their families. Since 1999, the Venison Donation Coalition has been highly successful in its goal to feed the hungry throughout New York State. They have processed and average of 38 tons of venison each year and more than 3.3 million servings of highly nutritious meat was served to individuals and children in need.

Ninety-five cents of every dollar is used towards processing the venison. In 2008, \$105,000 was spent on venison processing fees and 81,228 lbs of venison was processed and distributed to those in need. Anywhere hunting and fishing licenses are sold can accept your donation. Just inform the D.E.C.A.L.S. license agent of your wish to make a donation to support the Venison Donation Program.
