Enclosed is your New York State Parks gift card! The gift card is usable at many campgrounds and golf courses operated by the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation & Historic Preservation.

Included are your guidelines for use and a list of participating facilities. Please review before using your gift card.

- **Gift card may be used for:**

Camping reservations and walk ups

Golf reservations and greens fees

Camping supplies, firewood, ice, etc...only when provided by the Agency

- **Gift card may not be used for:**

Camping stays or services at facilities operated by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Adirondack and Catskill area facilities)

Other fees including, but not limited to, vehicle use fees, entrance fees, facility and equipment rentals, permits, etc...

Services or items provided by a concessionaire, Friends group or for which funds are deposited into a Natural Heritage Trust Account
