Request a list of State-certified M/WBEs from AGENCY and solicitations from them directly. Where feasible, divide the work into smaller portions to enhanced participations by M/WBEs and encourage the formation of join venture and other partnerships among M/WBE contractors to enhance their participation. Document and maintain records of bid solicitation, including those to M/WBEs and the results thereof. The Contractor will also maintain records of actions that its subcontractors have taken toward meeting M/WBE contract participation goals. Ensure that progress payments to M/WBEs are made on a timely basis so that undue financial hardship is avoided, and that bonding and other credit requirements are waived or appropriate alternatives developed to encourage M/WBE participation.	d (c) At the request of the contracting agency, this organization shall trequest each employment agency, labor union, or authorized representative will not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, age, disability or marital status and that such union or representative will affirmatively cooperate in the implementation of this organization's obligations herein.
