1			<p>If I understand the specifications correctly. Once the trees are felled, the wood and brush remains on site where it lays. The only stipulation is that it needs to be slashed to no higher than 3' above ground and the logs must be cut shorter than 8'. My crew does not, therefore, need to do any cleanup like chipping. It looks as if the material is primarily pitch pine. Additionally, between receiving bid results and starting the job, the state will mark all trees under consideration.</p>	<p>As stated in Section 2.4 Cutting Period, trees must be felled away from the trail, and where applicable, avoiding waterbodies, wetlands, recreation trails, roads, parking lots, private property, railways, power lines, and other infrastructure and if a felled tree blocks a trail, parking lot, road, or other infrastructure, the Contractor will be required to move the downed tree immediately until the infrastructure is no longer impacted. All services must be performed in accordance with the IFB.</p> <p>As amended in IFB Amendment 1, OPRHP is not requiring chipping with this project. However, if the Contractor deems it necessary during the process of tree felling they can request permission from OPRHP, at no additional cost to OPRHP.</p> <p>The material is primarily pitch pine.</p> <p>OPRHP will mark trees prior to the start of the project.</p>
2			<p>Do you have bid results from any comparable type jobs in recent years?</p>	<p>There are no other OPRHP comparable type jobs in recent years similar to this project.</p>
3			<p>Do you have idea on how many trees will be marked?</p>	<p>As stated in the IFB the amount of trees that will be marked will not exceed 10,000.</p>

4			Is this a one time thing or continuing?	This contract is only for the timeframe provided.
5			Who is person who approves job when done?	OPRHP will assign a Regional Respresentative as the primary contact to provide direction and approvals for the term of the Contract.
