#### A. Revisions to IFB

The changes found below are outlined within the IFB document as well. Language that has been added is demonstrated by an underline, language that has been deleted is demonstrated by a strikethrough. This Amendment 1 has been noted on the front page of the procurement document package as well as in the header of each subsequent page.

#### 1. Page 9, Section 2.2 Facility Requirements

Distance of transfer facility from park has been updated.

- Considering wear and tear on OPRHP vehicles, as well as staff time utilized for transportation, the provided transfer facility address must be located less than <u>50</u> 40 miles round trip (maximum <u>25</u> <del>20</del> miles one-way) from Wildwood State Park. Bidders must use Google Maps (<a href="http://maps.google.com">http://maps.google.com</a>) to determine the mileage to Wildwood State Park.

Distance of transfer facility from park has been updated.

## Mileage to Wildwood State Park:

Per Section 2.2 Facility Requirements, mileage will be used for evaluation purposes only. All figures must be rounded to two decimal places. Bidder's disposal site/transfer facility must be located less than 50 40 miles round trip (maximum 25 20 miles one-way) from Wildwood State Park 790 Hulse Landing Rd. Wading River, NY 11792). Bidders must use Google Maps (<a href="http://maps.google.com">http://maps.google.com</a>) to determine the milage to Wildwood State Park.
