RESOLUTION

June 15, 2020

Section 408.1. Activities absolutely prohibited

The activities and uses enumerated in this section shall be absolutely prohibited on property under the jurisdiction, custody and control of the commission.

(a) Failure to wear face coverings and prohibition on non-essential gatherings during the COVID-19 state disaster emergency declared by Executive Order 202.

(1) Every person over the age of two, and who can medically tolerate a face covering, shall wear an acceptable face covering if they come within six feet of another person who is not a member of their household. Acceptable face coverings for COVID-19 include but are not limited to cloth-based face coverings and disposable masks that cover both the mouth and nose.

(2) Any gathering of people who are not members of the same household or family unit shall constitute a non-essential gathering and is prohibited pursuant to Executive Order 202.10, as extended by subsequent Executive Orders. [[Reserved]]

On motion made and duly seconded, it was

RESOLVED that the Commission approve the aforementioned amendment of the existing subdivision (a) of Section 408.1 of 9 NYCRR "Activities absolutely prohibited."
