Allan H. Treman State Marine Park Boaters:

Note: This application for seasonal boat slip licenses is new. Please read carefully before returning to application materials to Robert Treman State Park.

License applications for the 2021 season will be accepted between **January 15th** and **January 31st**. Applications dropped off at Robert Treman State Park office or postmarked after the January 31st deadline will be processed on a first come, first served basis. This applies even if you are a returning boater in your 5-year agreement. Boaters who were assigned slips in 2016 will be New Boaters this year.

Boat slips are assigned by OPRHP and slip assignments are not guaranteed year to year for returning boaters, with the following exceptions:

- a. Boaters who have participated in the returning boater registration and occupied their slip each full season from 2017 forward shall be considered returning boaters for the 2021 season.
- b. Boaters who have participated in the returning boater registration and occupied their slip each full season from 2018 forward shall be considered returning boaters through the 2022 season, provided their renewal application is received by the deadline for each year.
- c. Boaters who have participated in the returning boater registration and occupied their slip each full season from 2019 forward shall be considered returning boaters through the 2023 season, provided their renewal application is received by the deadline for each year.
- d. Boaters who have participated in the returning boater registration and occupied their slip each full season from 2020 forward shall be considered returning boaters through the 2024 season, provided their renewal application is received by the deadline for each year.

By 2024, the returning boater program will have been phased out, and all slips designated for seasonal rental will be available to any interested applicant at the start of the open application period on a first come, first served basis.

Only completed applications will be processed.

1. To be considered complete applications must include a signature and date, a copy of your registration or US Coast Guard documentation showing proof of length, proof of insurance and payment in full.
2. If you have not returned your restroom key, you must send the card or a separate check for \$10 **with your application**. If the card or a check for the replacement fee is not included, your application will not be processed.
3. Boat slips will not be held for incomplete applications. If your registration is not received or postmarked by January 31st, your application will not be on time and you will be considered a new boater.

Proof of registration is required **every year**. You can print registration details information to include with your application from the New York State DMV website. Go to dmv.ny.gov. Click on **MyDMV Login** at the top right of the page. Sign in to your account, or register and print from there.

We work hard to keep costs down, while providing you with a safe and rewarding recreational experience. To that end, we are happy to report that the fees for seasonal slips will be the same as they were last year.

We anticipate the marina will open on Friday, May 1, 2021. The marina will close the **third** Monday in October. This allows for more time to winterize the marina, including placing the bubbler system to protect the piers from ice damage. Please be sure to remove your boats promptly. Winterization work needs to begin immediately after the closing date.

This year the marina will close on Monday, October 18, 2021 at 8 a.m.

Boats still in the marina after 8 a.m. Monday October 18, 2021 will be charged a per night fee of \$15.00 for non-electric slips and \$21.00 for electric slips and may also be subject to towing/impound fees. The slip holders will also lose their place as returning boaters (if applicable) and would need to apply as new boaters the following season.

Additional Reminders:

- 1) Thoroughly review the Terms and Conditions listed on this NEW application as well as the Marina Policies and Procedures included in the mailing. The marina is a public park. All patrons and boaters have a right to a safe, friendly and relaxing environment.
- 2) Boat lengths are rounded UP partial foot lengths, not down. Fees are calculated based on your registration or coast guard documentation. Please inform us if your swim platform is not included in your boat length. Slip placement will be based on length of the vessel with attachments. **Registrations are required every year and applications will not be processed without them.**
- 3) Any watercraft with a separate registration number (jet skis) **cannot** be kept in slips with boats. Kayaks and dinghies that share the registration with a larger vessel are permitted. You may purchase a slip for the additional vessel.
- 4) All commercial activities conducted in the marina require a permit. Please contact us for more information.
- 5) Subletting of slips, independently or through a third party such as Airbnb, is strictly prohibited.
- 6) Quiet Hours start at 10 p.m. and end at 7 a.m. Be respectful and courteous to your neighbors.
- 7) As per the slip agreement there is to be **NO** screwing, nailing or fastening that involves penetrating the structures in the marina. Park management reserves the right to remove affixed items. This includes but is not limited to finger piers and standoff pilings.
- 8) Please notify us in writing if you sell your boat. Your boat slip license terminates upon transfer of ownership of the boat. The new boat owner will need to contact the marina office to purchase a slip. Boat slip licenses are non-transferrable.
- 9) If you are paying with a credit card and applying online, you can send your credit card information securely through the DocuSign application. If you are mailing your application and would like to pay with credit card -*please indicate the best time and phone number to reach you.* We will contact you when we're prepared to process your payment over the phone.
- 10) In effect on 1/1/2020: **Brianna's Law** will require all operators of motorized watercraft to complete a state approved boating safety course by the year 2025.

If you were born after January 1, 1988, you will need a boating safety certification when operating a motorized vessel by 2022.

Anyone operating a Personal Watercraft (JetSki™, Wave Runner™, etc.) must have a boating safety certificate, and be at least 14 years of age or older.

All operators of motorized vessels, regardless of age, will need boating safety certification by January 1, 2025.
