

Allan H. Treman State Park Seasonal Slip Applications

Seasonal Slip Applications will be available to reserve beginning at 8 am on Wednesday, February 1, 2023.

The application process is **2** steps.

Step 1: Boaters should select and pay for the appropriately sized slip according to **overall length** of their vessel by going to **Reserve America**. Once the conditional slip reservation is made, boaters will receive a confirmation email from Reserve America with a Link to Step 2.

Step 2: Click the link in your confirmation email to complete the electronic Slip License Agreement via DocuSign. To be considered complete, all applications must include these documents:

- A valid copy of your registration *or* US Coast Guard documentation showing proof of length (expired registrations will not be accepted).
- Proof of vessel insurance (provide a current Declarations page which shows coverage amounts).

From the Application:

Section 10. Insurance

During the term of this license, Licensee must hold a policy of marine protection and indemnity insurance for the licensed boat covering <u>bodily injury</u>, <u>damage to property other than the boat</u> itself, and fuel/oil spills with a minimum liability limit of \$300,000.

NOTE: In order for your slip application to be considered complete, boaters will need to complete all parts of the application process *within 10 days* of making the initial reservation. If the slip agreement, insurance, and registration information are not complete within 10 days, *the initial reservation will be voided and refunded, and the selected slip will be placed back online for reservation by the public.*

Also, if you are 39 years old or younger (born on or after January 1, 1983), you must provide a **Boater Safety Certificate** to complete your application (this applies to sail boats with auxiliary motors as well).
