

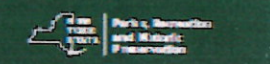


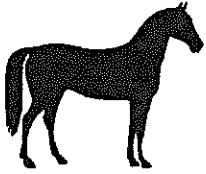

 Preserve Closed at Sunset

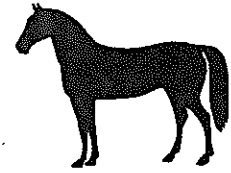
Remain on Bridle Paths

1. Permit must be attached to and visible on equine's saddle or harness.
2. Mounted horses must be properly saddled and bridled.
3. Driven horses must be properly harnessed to a safe carriage and follow the rules of the road.
4. Equines in hand must be haltered and properly supervised.
5. Riding limited to defined trails. Avoid hiking paths, streams, fishing sites, platforms, wet or marshy areas, building complexes and restricted areas.
6. Horses must be ridden at walk, trot, or canter only. No galloping or racing.
7. Meet or pass horses, hikers, and vehicles in a single file at a walk.
8. Riding double is prohibited.
9. Horses with known vices such as biting, kicking, etc... must be identified by the traditional custom of a small red ribbon on the tail.
10. In accordance with Agriculture & Markets rules and regulations, part 64; a current Coggins certificate is required for all horses that are transported. Riders may be required to produce a certificate upon request. It is recommended that horses be vaccinated yearly for Equine Encephalitis and Rabies.
11. Wearing an approved helmet is mandatory under 16 years old and strongly recommended for all riders.
12. Unruly horses, recklessness, or violations may result in revocation of permit.
13. No Smoking, No Littering, and No Dogs, Pets, or loose livestock permitted.
