Snowshoe Trail Map

Appalachian Way

This 2.5 hour hike is recommended for experienced snowshoers capable of negotiating rugged terrain. The trail is marked with blue markers.

Weather adversely affects this trail. On exposed downhills, the trail can become icy, making descents very challenging.


On the ridge, the snowshoe trail follows the AT hiking trail, which is marked with white rectangular blazes painted on trees.

At the overlook, the white blazes are painted on the bedrock. It is possible that snow and ice may cover these markers.

Ojigwan Path

Enjoy this 2.5 hour hike, good for beginner and intermediate snowshoers. The trail is marked with orange markers.

Pay careful attention!
 The snowshoe trail leaves the AT hiking trail approx. 1/4 mile after the lake overlook.
 The return trail is marked with blue markers.
