ARCHERY/CROSSBOW DATES:

East Side: October 1 – December 16, 2025 & December 26 – January 1, 2026 West Side: October 14 – December 16, 2025 & December 26 – January 1, 2026

MUZZLELOADING SEASON EAST & WEST

Monday, December 8 – 16, 2025 & December 26 – January 1, 2026

- ALL activities on State Park lands are regulated. Please check with the park office if you have any questions.
- 2. Each person must obtain and possess a permit while archery hunting on State Park Lands.
- 3. Before hunting in the park, you must obtain a permit at the park office or on-line. You need to obtain this permit only once for archery/muzzleloading/crossbow season. This is your actual Permit.
- 4. This permit is valid from October 1, 2025 through January 1, 2026 in accordance to East and West side opening dates listed above.
- 5. Archery/Muzzleloading/Crossbow is permitted during appropriate DEC Hunting seasons.
- 6. All forms of target shooting, including sighting in guns, bows, or crossbows, are prohibited.
- 7. NO permanent tree stands are permitted. Temporary tree stands are allowed **1 week** prior to season but must not damage trees and must be removed by dusk January 5th. Tree stands not removed by this date will be removed and destroyed.
- 8. Motorized vehicles are prohibited on trails and closed areas.
- 9. Letchworth State Park lands are within WMU 8M.
- 10. To better manage Big Game population ALL hunters are required to return a completed survey as a condition of your permit. Failure to return survey will result in you not being eligible to receive a permit next year.
- 11. NOTE: HUNTING IN THE SPECIAL SOUTHERN ARCHERY ZONE REQUIRES AN ADDITIONAL PERMIT. PLEASE VISIT https://parks.ny.gov/parks/letchworth/details.aspx FOR MORE INFORMATION.

Hunting Area—WEST of the Genesee River (see attached map)

- 1. Both sides of the Main Park Road from Castile to Hogsback. EXCLUDED are posted safety zones.
- 2. Southeast of 19A, South of Finn Rd, Northeast of Griffith Road.
- 3. North of the Dam Overlook to Upper Mt. Morris Road. Both sides of road.
- 4. Keep 500 feet from structures. (Note: The Safety Zone has been expanded near the Gibsonville Road and "C" Cabin areas. Please refer to the map for changes).
- 5. Follow DEC Rules for hunting distances from structures. (See safety zones on map)

Hunting Area—EAST of the Genesee River. The eastern side of the park east of the Genesee River, as far North as the Damsite Road, EXCLUDING the Parade Grounds and Cabin Area D which are south of Trail 7 and west of the park Rd; also EXCLUDING the park land south of Route 436 which is NOT in Wildlife Management unit 8M.

Archery Only areas are open during regular season for archery.

MUZZLELOADING SEASON EAST & WEST

December 8 - December 16, 2025 & December 26 - January 1, 2026
