POPULAR HIKES AT LETCHWORTH STATE PARK - ACCESS TO THE GENESEE RIVER IS NOT ALLOWED.

 GORGE TRAIL HIKE – Turn left out of parking lot, continue down the road, staying to the left of the monument. Turn left past the Glen Iris Inn (Big Yellow Building) onto Middle Upper Falls area. Park in the parking lot, follow trail to the right Upper Falls (Railroad Trestle) or to the left for approximately 3 miles to get to the Lower Falls Area.

Option #2 – GORGE TRAIL HIKE – Turn left out of the parking lot, approximately ¼ mile to Inspiration Point. Trail 1 to the left (1 ½ miles to Lower Falls) Trail 1 to the right (1 ½ miles to Upper/Middle Falls.

- LOWER FALLS AREA Turn right out of parking lot, follow Lower Falls Road past Cabin Area B. Park in the parking lot. Access trail 6A to the left of the picnic area. Approximately 127 stairs leading down to the area.
- 3. Option #2 LOWER FALLS AREA to MIDDLE/UPPER FALLS Turn right out of parking lot, follow Lower Falls Road past Cabin Area B. Park in the parking lot. Access trail 6A to the left of the picnic area. Approximately 127 stairs leading down to the area. When coming up from the Lower Falls area, turn to the left and follow the trail 1 to Middle/Upper Falls area. Approximately 6 miles round trip.
- LEE'S LANDING Turn right out of parking lot, follow Lower Falls Road toward Cabin Area A, park in parking lot and hike to the left on Trail #5 - trail head near CCC statue – Trail can be muddy and has a steep incline.
- WOLF CREEK AREA Turn right out of parking lot, follow main park road approximately 4 ½ miles to Wolf Creek Area. Park in parking lot and hike the ¼ mile of Trail 1 to top of hill by Tea Table.
- 6. HOGSBACK (Trail 20) North end- Turn right out of parking lot, follow main park road to Hogsback area (approximately 14 miles). Park in parking area, pick up Trail (20) and hike 3 miles north to Dam viewing area.
- NATURE HIKE Trout Pond Area Connect trails 2, 2A and 3. Park at the Trout Pond area. Turn left out of Parking Lot follow park road to monument stay to the right. Follow Trout Pond Road to parking area. Follow boardwalk to connect all three trails.
