Parking

There are 2 parking lots at Midway: a gravel lot and a grass lot. The entrances are right next to each other as you come down our main drive. Access to the Picnic Shelters is through the gravel lot on a dirt access road. Only two vehicles are allowed to be parked at each Picnic Shelter. Please unload and return your vehicle to the main parking lots.

Vehicles not parked in a lot or a designated legal parking spot are subject to tow.

For your safety PLEASE use the crosswalks from the parking lots to the rides area.

Catering/Food

1. Catering is available from our park concessionaire, Ready About Sailing. Please call Manager Sean directly at 716-763-1525 for booking and additional information.
2. Any group that employs a private caterer must pay a \$35.00 catering permit fee and a \$15.00 processing fee (\$50.00) regardless of whether or not they reserve a shelter.
3. There is food for purchase by our park concessionaire. You are welcome to bring family picnic baskets on your outing for no charge.
4. All grills are charcoal grills. You must supply all equipment necessary to use grills. This includes charcoal, lighters, lighter fluid and utensils.

Other Information

1. Alcoholic beverage permits are required for groups serving alcohol. There is no charge for this permit. Please call the park office for an application.
2. Special Use permits are required for all tents, bands and other special activities. There is a \$15.00 fee for this permit. Contact the park office for details and application.
3. A processing fee of \$9.00 is deducted from all refund payments. For cancellations made more than 30 days prior to the reserved date, a full (100%) refund will be issued. For cancellations made prior to ten (10) days before the reserved date, a 50% refund will be issued. No refunds shall be issued for cancellations made less than ten (10) days prior to the date of reservation.

Boat Docking

Coming by water? We have free day use boat dockage available on a first come, first serve basis. Available Mid-June through Labor Day. Please do not dock in the area reserved for the Chautauqua Belle Steamboat!
