Thank you for your interest in storing your boat at Moreau Lake. Boat storage will be selected through a lottery system:

- Applicants will submit this application for a chance to be selected for a boat storage spot at Moreau Lake State Park. **This application does not guarantee a storage spot.**
- Only one application per person may be submitted.** Multiple applications submitted by an individual will be automatically disqualified. **Secondary Occupant may not apply if they are already listed as a Secondary Occupant.**
- Primary Occupant must be 18 years or older.
- Winning applicants must show photo ID (Driver's License) at the Park Office when claiming their Boat Storage Permit.**
- Receiving a Boat Storage Permit on behalf of someone else will not be permitted.** Winning applicants (both Primary and Secondary) must show up in person at the Park Office with photo ID to claim a Boat Storage Permit.
- Winning applicants will be **designated** to an individual rack spot through lottery selection. The designated rack spot will be chosen at random based on the rack tier selection(s) that the applicant lists in Rack Tier Select. **There is no choice in rack tier selection after the lottery is drawn, so please choose the rack tiers appropriately when applying.**

Applications will be accepted (by mail or at the park office) from March 1, 2025 – April 1, 2025. Applications submitted or postmarked after 4/1/2025 will not be accepted.

Winning lottery results will be announced on April 10, 2025. Please visit [parks.ny.gov/parks/150/](https://parks.ny.gov/parks/150/) for a list of winners.

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## Terms and Conditions

This application will serve as the Boat Storage Permit for winning applicants and will only be valid once signed by a Park Representative. The permit will grant the holder permission to secure their boat at Moreau Lake State Park subject to the following conditions:

1. The boat storage fee is ninety-five dollars (**\$95.00 per boat**). Permit is valid from the date of issuance through **11/01/2025** or until revoked (subject to change without notice). Checks are made payable to **NYS Parks**.
2. Use is to correspond with park hours, which are 8 a.m. until dusk.
3. The Park Vehicle Use Fee per vehicle still applies. Boat Storage Permit does not grant free entrance into the park.
4. All boats must be stored only at the Boat Rack Storage Area located in the beach/picnic area.
5. The permit holder must lock the boat and remove all other equipment when not in use.
6. The permit holder understands and agrees to comply with the parks Carry In / Carry Out program. This means that you are required to remove everything you bring into the park (excluding boat(s) being stored) when you leave, including all garbage.
7. Any boats or equipment remaining on the grounds after 11/01/2025 or upon permit revocation will be removed at the owner's expense and risk.
8. Boat Decals issued to winning applicants must be fastened securely to the bow on the starboard (right) side.
9. No motors are permitted.
10. It is also understood by the undersigned that the activity permitted by the agreement is subject to the normal operating rules and regulations of the Agency as contained in the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules and Regulations of the State of New York. Should violation of these rules occur which are not corrected upon direction of employee, officer or agent, they are empowered to immediately cancel this permit and take such other remedial and/or legal action as may be provided for by law.
11. It is also mutually understood and agreed that the permit holder specifically agrees to indemnify and save harmless the State of New York and/or the commissioners of the Saratoga/Capital District Region, New York State Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation, it's successors, assigns, representatives and employees from claims, suits, actions, damages and costs of every kind or description, arising out of or resulting from any act or omission relating to this activity.
12. This permit is not transferable and shall not constitute your authorization to undertake any said activity until the agency has received your acknowledgement of the receipt of this communication and your agreement to the terms and conditions set forth herein.
13. Every pleasure vessel including canoes, kayaks and rowboats operated upon the waters of NYS must have on board one U.S. Coast Guard approved wearable PFD for each person on the vessel. In addition, vessels 16 feet and greater in length must also carry a type IV throwable PFD. Please see <https://parks.ny.gov/documents/recreation/boating/PFDLawsOfNewYork.pdf> for more information.
