Applications for a 2024 Indigenous Artisan Permit are due NO LATER THAN Friday, March 22nd, 2024. The drawing will be held on Monday, March 25th, 2024, at 11:00am at DeVeaux Woods State Park, 3160 Deveaux Woods Dr., Niagara Falls, NY 14305.

Applicants are welcome to attend but not required to be present.

Each applicant MUST submit proof of Indigenous/Native American/First Nations status or heritage and PHOTO ID with the completed permit application. Failure to comply will result in disqualification of the applicant. Applicants must be 18 years or older to be eligible. Any disputes regarding eligibility must be presented in writing, to the Niagara Falls State Park permit office within 1 (one) week of permit drawing. Disputes will be resolved in communication with respective tribal nation leaders.

Items sold are to be traditional Indigenous handmade crafts. NO EXCEPTIONS

Six (6) names will be drawn. Each of the 6 winners may select a second seller who will be named on their permit. Second sellers must also provide proof of Indigenous/Native American status or heritage and photo ID to qualify.

PLEASE NOTE: Anyone who is chosen to receive a permit, or their 2^{nd} seller, MUST SET UP AND USE THE PERMIT or another name will be selected. Non-use of the permit will result in forfeiture of that year's permit.

The permit will be valid from April 1st, 2024 through March 31st, 2025
