POOL RULES

- Everyone must purchase a wristband. Everyone must be present at the cashier booth to receive a wristband. There is no holding spots. Wristband must be on for re-entry. Everyone must wait on the pool line to get in, even wristband holders.
- No food or drinks allowed, except for sealed bottles of water
- No refillable water bottles. No cups.
- No coolers or ice.
- No radios/Speakers of any kind.
- Lockers are available for use and are first come first served, the cost is 50 cents per usage.
- Tents are not allowed.
- No sports equipment or toys of any kind, including water guns. Fins, snorkels, and goggles that cover the nose are not permitted.
- No life jackets or flotation devices of any kind, unless they are Coast Guard approved.
- Patrons who bring bags to the pool must have their bags checked prior to entering the pool.
- Children aged 10 and under must be under close supervision, observation, and control at all times by an adult (age 18+).
- Children who are not toilet trained, or persons who are incontinent, must wear a swim diaper in the pool.
- Smoking/vaping is not permitted inside the pool area and entrance.

Failure to follow the rules could result in you being asked to leave the pool area.
