

Wildwood State Park's Field 1 parking lot and beach access walkway will be undergoing a total renovation through the end of 2024 and into the early part of 2025. During the time that the project is ongoing:

- Day-use parking is available in the grass 'Green Parking Pass Second Car' parking field located on the right-hand side of the road just after the park entrance. This parking field is located between the basketball court and the flagpole. The entrance to the 'Green Parking Pass' lot is marked with a large brown sign and other temporary parking signage.
- The restroom, picnic area and playground will be accessible by the pedestrian walkway gap in the chain link-fence that's along the west edge of the hill. From the 'Green Parking Pass Second Car' parking area the gap in the fence is down the hill from the flagpole.
- Hunting Station 1 parking will be located at the bottom of the hill on the right-hand side of the road just after the stop sign and pedestrian crosswalk. The Hunting Station parking area will be between the two white barricades and marked with the Hunting Station 1 signage.
- Nighttime Sport Fishing Permit parking is available in the grass 'Green Parking Pass Second Car' parking field located on the right-hand side of the road just after the park entrance. This parking field is located between the basketball court and the flagpole. The entrance to the 'Green Parking Pass' lot is marked with a large brown sign and other temporary parking signage.
- Stargazing Permit and Nighttime Photography permit parking will be available in the grass 'Green Parking Pass Second Car' parking field located on the right-hand side of the road just after the park entrance. This parking field is located between the basketball court and the flagpole. The entrance to the 'Green Parking Pass' lot is marked with a large brown sign and other temporary parking signage. Stargazing is permitted in the grass athletic field next to this parking area and Nighttime photography in the athletic field next to this parking area in addition to the beach (when accessible).
- At times, access to the beachfront may be closed due to renovation activity along the beach access walk.
