STATE PARKS ANNOUNCES PHEASANT HUNT LOTTERY

The Niagara Frontier Region of New York State Parks today announced that the annual permit lottery for the 2024 pheasant hunting season will take place Monday, October 7th, this will include the drawing for both the Youth Hunt and the Regular Season Hunt.

Youth Hunt Permits will be required for the two days of the special youth hunting weekend – Saturday, October 12th and Sunday, October 13th. The Youth Hunt this year will allow for a second hunter on the permit. For the Regular Season Hunt, permits will be required for the three days expected to draw the heaviest hunting traffic – October 19th, 26th & November 02nd.

There will be two separate hunts each day. The first hunt will be from sunrise to 12:30 p.m. The second hunt will be from 12:30 p.m. to sunset.

Hunting throughout the regular pheasant season, from October 19th to December 31st, is allowed at three State Parks: Golden Hill, Joseph Davis, and Wilson-Tuscarora; <u>Except, No Hunting is permitted during</u> the open firearm season for deer. Permits, however, are required on October 12th, 13th (youth hunt) and on October 19th, 26th and November 02nd (regular season).

As in the past, stocking will be done by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation. No hunting is allowed on the following Friday release days: October 18th, 25th and on November 01st. There is no fee for the permit and hunters awarded permits will have the option of naming one additional hunter on their permit.

Hunters interested in entering the Permit Lottery should mail in a separate, standard-size 3 x 5 file card or postcard for each date and park you would like to hunt. Only one permit will be issued to each hunter per day. Cards may be put into one envelope for each respective park and mailed together to the appropriate address listed below:

The file card should include: Applicant's name, address, telephone number, email address, hunting license back tag number, hunt date, AM hunt or PM hunt, and whish desired park location. Entries will be computerized to avoid duplications. All your lottery entries must be received by noon on Monday, September 30.
