HOW MANY PEOPLE WILL MY BOAT BE ABLE TO CARRY?

NYS Parks uses 174 lbs per person.

To figure the number of persons your boat can carry you need to divide the total weight capacity on the capacity plate by 174 lbs and round down. This will be your maximum capacity unless it exceeds the max person capacity on the plate. If the number exceeds the person capacity on the plate we will use the lower number.

Example from the plate on the front of this application:
7 persons or 1050lbs
1050/174 $=6.03$ persons
This office will round down this number to 6 persons for safety purposes.

This boat would be rated at 1 operator and 5 passengers.
