Long Island State Parks 2022 Metal Detecting Permit

- Fee: \$40.00 per permit
- Valid from January 1, 2022 – December 31, 2022 at LONG ISLAND STATE PARKS ONLY.
- Permit(s) will be mailed once processed. Please allow 10 – 14 business days for your permit(s) to arrive in the mail.

Metal Detector Permit will be used for HOBBY purposes only and in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by New York State.

Long Island State Parks Metal Detecting Rules and Regulations

1. Persons with Metal Detectors in pursuance of their hobby may not disturb other park patrons.
2. \$40.00 Metal Detector Permit Fee.
3. Metal Detectors may NOT be used in landscaped areas.
4. Tools larger than 1.5" wide by 6" long may NOT be used to dig.
5. ALL surfaces disturbed by digging MUST be immediately restored.
6. Any item recovered that is worth more than twenty dollars (\$20.00) MUST be turned in to the Park Police.
7. ALL trash MUST be placed in the proper receptacles.
8. Archeological Artifacts must NOT be removed from the park and MUST be turned in to the Park Police.
9. Any injuries incurred by the Permittee are the sole responsibility of the Permittee.
