Please note: Many winter activities are dependent on conditions. Ice fishing, for example, is controlled by ice thickness; the park manager makes the determination when it's good to walk out on the ice. Skiing and snowshoeing are only available when conditions allow. Not all trails are groomed.

FWP offers 20 km of machine groomed and tracked trails for skiers of all ability levels. We groom for classic and skate skiing. There is plenty of flat beginner terrain near the lodge for first time skiers.

Snowshoeing and Tubing

We have dedicated snowshoe trails and a sledding and tubing hill.

Rentals

Skis, Snowshoes and Tubes for all ages are rented in the lodge.

We have both classic and skate skis for rent.

Cafe

Our café provides hot food, snacks and hot and cold beverages. We have both indoor and outdoor seating and a fire pit.

Restrooms, changing rooms and showers provided onsite.
