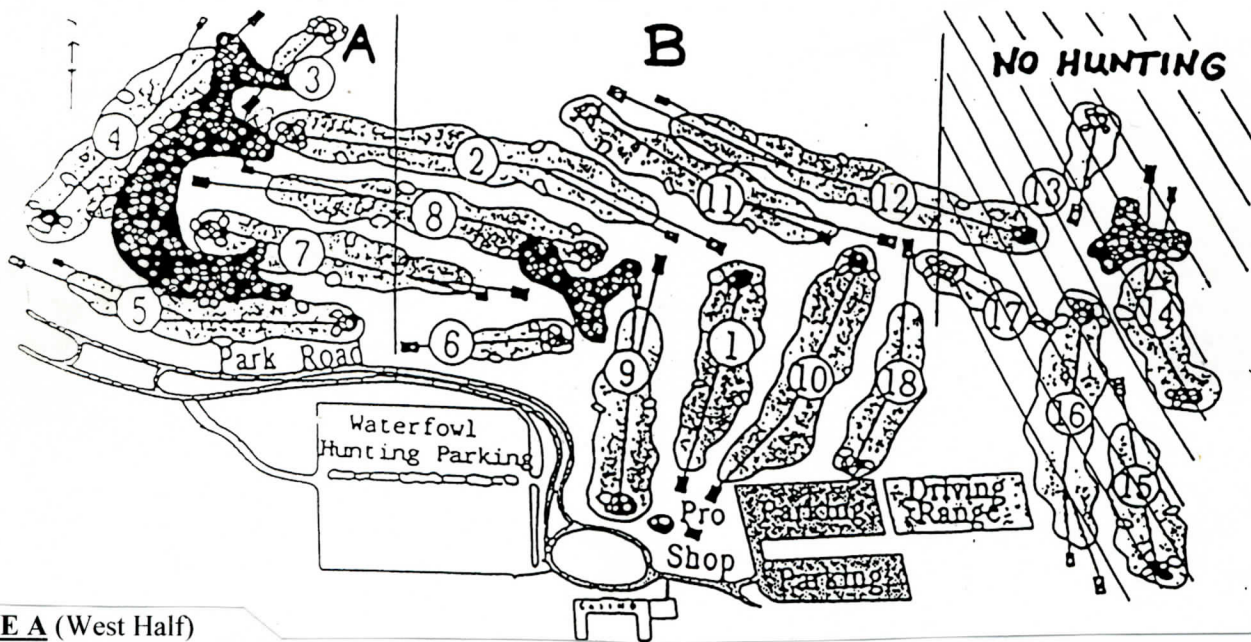
2017 – 2018 WATERFOWL HUNTING REGULATIONS & INFORMATION
**** GOLF COURSE SUPPLEMENT ****

INFORMATION

In addition to the 40 Niagara River waterfowl "blinds", two additional "blinds" will be available on the golf course beginning Saturday - November 11, 2017.

REGULATIONS

1. No vehicles permitted on the golf course.
2. Four (4) or less hunters per day per "blind".
3. No splitting of hunting party. Driving of geese is permitted.
4. Hunters must have an inflatable boat and/or dog for retrieval.
5. Setting of decoys and/or "blinds" and walking on elevated areas is prohibited (e.g. greens, tees, bunkers).
6. Hunting permitted from "**one-half hour before sunrise until NOON ONLY**".
7. Duck hunting is allowed at sites A and B only when it coincides with Canada goose season.
8. All hunting at sites A and B by permit only on designated days.
9. Hunting is subject to New York and Federal Fish and Wildlife Regulations.
10. All spent shell casings and litter must be picked up and must be removed from the golf course.



SITE A (West Half)

General Site Location: All of the golf course area bounded by the woods along fairway #4 east to a line of white stakes dividing green #5 and tee #6 through fairways #2, #7, and #8.

Specific "Blind" Location: One "blind" may be set up anywhere in the area described, except on golf course tees, greens, bunkers, or any other elevated area. "Blind" may be moved during the hunt. Caution should be taken not to shoot to the east (right) of the white stakes.

SITE B (East Half)

General Site Location: All of the golf course area from the line of white stakes dividing green #5 and tee #6 through fairways #2, #7, and #8 east to the line of red stakes.

Specific "Blind" Location: One "blind" may be set up anywhere in the area described, except on golf course tees, greens, bunkers, or any other elevated area. "Blind" may be moved during the hunt. Caution should be taken not to shoot to the west (left) of the white stakes.
