**FALL APPLICATIONS BEING ACCEPTED FOR AVAILABLE PUBLIC USE OF
ARTIFICIAL TURF FIELDS AT BRENTWOOD STATE PARK**

(Babylon, NY, September 21st, 2015) The New York Office of Parks, Recreation, and Historic Preservation is now accepting applications on a first-come, first-serve basis for available evening time slots for the artificial turf Fields #1 and #2 at Brentwood State Park.

Anyone interested in securing field usage for the fall season must complete a Park Use Application and either mail or hand-deliver the application to: Long Island State Park Headquarters, 625 Belmont Avenue, Babylon, NY 11702. Park Use Applications can be downloaded from the Long Island Region tab on www.nysparks.com.

Field #1 is a lighted, multi-use, artificial turf, full-size field. It is lined for both soccer and lacrosse. Field #1 availability and fees are as follows:

- Mondays, September 21 through November 9
 - 4:00p.m.-6:00p.m.; 6:00p.m.-8:00p.m.; 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- Saturdays, September 26 through November 14
 - 6:00p.m.-8:00p.m.; 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- The fee, per two-hour time slot, is \$200 plus an additional \$50 an hour for the use of lights

Field #2 is an artificial turf, full-size field, lined for soccer only. Portable lights will be used to illuminate this field. This field can be used for practices only. Field #2 availability and fees are as follows:

- Mondays, September 21 through November 9 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- Tuesdays, September 22 through November 10 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- Wednesdays, September 23 through November 11 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- Thursdays, September 24 through November 12 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- Fridays, September 25 through November 13 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- Saturdays, September 26 through November 14 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- Sundays, September 27 through November 15 8:00p.m.-10:00p.m.
- The fee, per two hour time slot, is \$200 plus an additional \$50 an hour for use of lights
