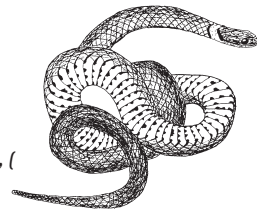

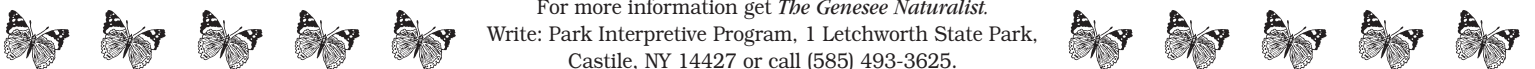

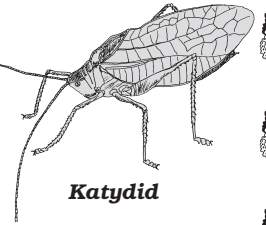


Giant Waterbug
