EQUESTRIAN RULES & INFO FOR MINNEWASKA STATE PARK PRESERVE &
GOOSEPOND MOUNTAIN & HIGHLAND LAKES STATE PARKS

1. **Please excuse our appearance in the 2018 season, we have begun a major capital campaign to improve our visitor experience. Beginning in the Spring we will be creating a connecting carriage road to bring visitors from the Awosting Parking Lot to the Awosting Falls trail head. This will get visitors off the vehicle access road. Beginning mid-Summer, we will be starting Phase 1 of our parking improvements. Regular vehicle access will be permitted 7 days a week and bus access will ONLY be permitted on non-holiday weekdays for the duration of the projects. Access detours and trail closures may be in place at times during this project, please call the park preserve office or check the website for updates.**
2. **Equestrian use will only be permitted on non-holiday weekdays, due to the contractors staging area in the Awosting Parking Area, which will limit parking capacity for the duration of the project.**
3. I agree to bring only equines certified to be free of Equine Infectious Anemia into the parks. I will produce upon request a current negative, New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets Equine Infection Anemia Test Record (negative Coggins test) for each equine brought into the park.
4. I understand that all riders/drivers under the age of 18 must wear an ASTM (American Society for Testing & Materials) approved riding helmet. All riders/drivers are strongly encouraged to wear approved riding helmets.
5. I agree to assume all risk in connection with this permit & will be solely responsible & answerable in damages for all accidents/injuries to person or property. I agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the People of the State of New York, the Executive Department, the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation; Palisades Interstate Park Commission; their commissioners, officers, agents and employees from and against damages for injury to or death of persons and for damage to or destruction of property of State Parks or others occurring during Permittee's use of said premises and caused by the acts, omissions, neglect or misconduct of Permittee or any of its employees, agents, contractors, licensees or guests in the conduct of Permittee's operations under this permit. The Permittee assumes all risk of loss of the Permittee's property or that of its agents, employees, contractors and guests. I agree that this permit will be binding upon me, my heirs, legal representative and assigns forever.
6. Permittee shall promptly report any and all unusual incidents directly to the Park Preserve Manager or Park Police. Unusual incidents include, but are not limited to, damage to park property, accidents, personal injuries, and emergencies involving medical personnel.
7. Ride at a walk, trot or canter. Galloping is prohibited. Horses must be properly saddled and bridled. Riding double or bareback is prohibited.
8. Each horse must have a rider who is in control of only one horse at a time.
9. Permits are issued to each rider not the horse and permits must be carried when riding.
10. Remember that these carriage roads are shared by other users, including hikers, bicyclists, runners and park staff in vehicles. Meet and pass all other users at a walk and in single file.
11. Horseback riding is allowed on designated carriage roads only. Horseback riding is not permitted on the Smiley Carriage Road or the Stony Kill Carriage Road.
12. Carriage Roads can be closed at any time.
13. Bow hunting for DEER ONLY is permitted at Highland Lakes State Park from 10/1/18 – 12/20/18. Hunting is permitted on weekdays only, no weekends.
