Rockefeller State Park Preserve

Land Steward: Do field work with Steven DiFalco, our Natural Resource Specialist, and our stewardship team. Dig and cut invasive vines and shrubs, and plant and care for native wildflowers. Days and times vary. No experience necessary.

Outreach and Pop-up Table: Help provide Preserve information and trail recommendations to park visitors in the entrance courtyard on weekends. Interact with families and kids. Learn and teach about our natural history and ecology! Work with Julia Jardine, Conservation Communicator. No experience necessary.

Events: The Preserve and our Friends group always need extra hands to help with the 10K race (Spring), the 5K race (Fall), the Ramble and Gamble Horse event (Fall), and more!

Tree Peony Garden: Volunteer Keith Austin and his crew of gardeners seek more volunteers to help them care for the Preserve's spectacular tree peony garden. Volunteers are particularly needed in spring and fall. No experience necessary.

Corporate Work Days: Rockefeller Preserve hosts volunteer workdays for corporate, church, school, and other groups of between 10 and 20 people. These workdays are a healthy opportunity for groups to engage in team-building and fulfillment of social responsibility goals while benefiting the environment.
