Pick up a Saratoga-Capital District Region Geocache  
Challenge Passport at a participating Historic Site or Park  
Office, or download a copy at [www.nysparks.com](http://www.nysparks.com).



Get the coordinates for each of the 72 Sara-Cap  
Challenge Caches. You can use your phone to play if you download a  
geocaching app, or visit [www.geocaching.com](http://www.geocaching.com) to get each  
set of coordinates, then enter them into a handheld GPS.



Go to each of the participating Parks and Historic Sites.



When you find each cache, sign the logbook and stamp  
your passport with the unique stamp that you find. You may  
take or trade items in the cache, but please leave the stamp  
behind for other cachers!



When you find caches at a park or historic site, feel free to  
stop by the park office and let us know how it went.

When you have successfully stamped your passport with 45  
of the total \*82 caches, you will be eligible to receive a  
trackable 2018 Sara-Cap Challenge geocoin. Bring your  
completed passport to Thacher, Moreau, or Schodack  
before Veteran's Day (November 11, 2018) for staff to  
verify your completed passport and to receive your prize.



\*Expand your travels and visit the Central Region and the  
Taconic Region. Find any 10 Challenge Caches in those  
Regions, and they will count toward your goal of 45 caches  
in the Saratoga-Capital District Region Geocache Challenge.

- You might encounter *wildlife*: deer, raccoons, groundhogs, coyote, snakes, snapping turtles, Canada geese, frogs, etc. *Please leave these animals alone*, and remember; they are more scared of you than you are of them.
- Before heading out, *download a Park Map* for each location, or get one at any Park Office. *If you get lost, stay put and use a whistle*. If you have a cell signal, *call Park Police* at (518) 584-2004.
